This Monday morning power and internet capabilities were restored to Village Hall. Warming and charging centers have been open at the Recreation Pool Building and Library. Warm showers are also available at the Recreation Pool Building.

The Village experienced over 145 downed trees. Our DPW staff has worked tirelessly with outside contractors to remove all debris from public roads and homes.

I have been in constant contact with LIPA, Nassau County OEM and all our elected officials before, during and after the storm. We have been informed by LIPA, that 90% of power will be restored by the end of Wednesday.

I have ordered the Recreation Pool Building to remain open for Village residents until power is restored.
