Section 1. Legislative Intent

The Board of Trustees has determined that it is necessary to reduce the speed limit on Tulip Avenue. This Local Law amends Section 96-74 of the Code of the Incorporated Village of Floral Park so as to reduce the speed limit on Tulip Avenue between Caroline Place and Harvard Street to 25 mph.

Section 2. Section 96-74 as Amended.

§ 96-74. Schedule II: Speed Limits.

In accordance with the provisions of § 96-5, speed limits are hereby established upon the following described streets or parts thereof:

Covert Avenue	30	100 feet south of railroad tracks
Garage Street	30	30 feet east of the pool
Jericho Turnpike	35	All
Landau Avenue	30	10 feet north of Webster Avenue
Plainfield Avenue	30	150 south of Vandewater Avenue
South Tyson	20	Within school zone

Stewart Street	25	At the pool and Garage Street
Tulip Avenue	25	Between <u>Caroline Place</u> and <u>Harvard Street</u>

Section 3. Severability

If a court determines that any clause, sentence, paragraph, subdivision, or part of this local law or the application thereof to any person, firm or corporation, or circumstance is invalid or unconstitutional, the court's order or judgment shall not affect, impair, or invalidate the remainder of this local law, but shall be confined in its operation to the clause, sentence, paragraph, subdivision, or part of this local law or in its application to the person, individual, firm or corporation or circumstance, directly involved in the controversy in which such judgment or order shall be rendered.

Section 4. Effective Date

This local law shall take effect immediately upon filing with the Secretary of State.
