As the Board continues its research and determination whether such uses should be deemed permitted under the Code, an extension of the moratorium is in order.

The Village Board of Trustees requested the moratorium be enacted so that it might have sufficient opportunity to evaluate the permitted uses in the Village's Business Districts and to determine whether the permitted uses should be statutorily amended, altered, modified, expanded or repealed. This moratorium will provide an opportunity for the Village Board of Trustees to evaluate the changes needed without the possibility of new businesses opening that might conflict with the plan being developed. The Village Board determined a moratorium be established prohibiting certain permitted uses in the Business District. In establishing this moratorium, the Village Board of Trustees has also considered:

1. The need for conserving the value of buildings and land and the need to encourage the most appropriate use of land.

2. The need to attract retail business of such a character as to encourage, foster and

promote the revitalization of the Business Districts.

3. To ensure adequate parking and lessen congestion, while balancing the need for business growth.

4. To provide adequate light and air.

5. To ensure physical compatibility with surrounding uses.

6. To establish a comprehensive plan, without the pressure of new businesses that conflict with the overall goal of revitalization.

To encourage historic preservation.

### Section 2. Prohibitions:

By adoption of that local for the extended term hereof, no further subdivisions will be permitted within the Village.

## Section 3. Geographic Scope:

This local law shall apply to any parcel of land, whether wholly or, partially within, the Incorporated Village of Floral Park.

#### Section 4. Term:

This moratorium shall remain in effect for an additional period of one (1) additional year from the date of its adoption by the Board of Trustees.

## Section 5. Severability

If a court determines that any clause, sentence, paragraph, subdivision, or part of this local law or the application thereof to any person, firm or corporation, or circumstance is invalid or unconstitutional, the court's order or judgment shall not affect, impair, or invalidate the remainder of this local law, but shall be confined in its operation to the clause, sentence, paragraph, subdivision, or part of this local law or in its application to the person, individual, firm or corporation or circumstance, directly involved in the controversy in which such judgment or order shall be rendered.

## Section 6. Effective Date

This local law shall take effect immediately upon filing with the Secretary of State.
