A Public Hearing for the Board of Trustees was held on the above date at 8:45 pm. Village Attorney John E. Ryan noted for the record that the legal notice sent to area residents had the correct venue address. The Board of Trustees agreed to delay the hearing for 20 minutes to accommodate residents who had gone to the wrong venue.

The meeting opened with a Pledge to the Flag. Present were Mayor Thomas J. Tweedy, Trustees Kevin M. Fitzgerald, Dominick A. Longobardi, Lynn Pombonyo and Archie T. Cheng, Village Administrator Gerard M. Bambrick, Village Clerk Susan E. Walsh, Superintendent of Building Department and Superintendent of Public Works Stephen L. Siwinski, Police Commissioner Stephen McAllister and Village Attorney John E. Ryan.

Purpose: The application of Wendy's Restaurants, lessee, 181-191 Jericho Turnpike, Floral Park, NY 11001, is made in accordance with Chapter 99, Article III, Section 99-11 B, of the Zoning Ordinance of the Incorporated Village of Floral Park, NY, which states that a building in a B-2 District may be erected, altered or used for any purpose only when authorized by the Board of Trustees as a special use after a public hearing conducted by the Board of Trustees.

Trustee Pombonyo offered Resolution No. 2016-145 to close the hearing and reserve decision.
