A Public Hearing for the Board of Trustees was held on the above date at 8:35 pm.

The application of Benjamin Borgognone, owner, 225 Jericho Turnpike, Floral Park, NY 11001, is made in accordance with Chapter 99, Article III, Section 99-11 B (1) of the Zoning Ordinance of the Incorporated Village of Floral Park, NY, which sets forth the permitted uses and special uses in a B-2 District and which provides that in a B-2 District a restaurant may only be erected, altered or used when authorized by the Board of Trustees as a special use after a public hearing conducted by the Board of Trustees. This application is also made in accordance with Chapter 99, Article I, Section 99-6, Schedule of Regulations, which requires an additional 20 parking spaces, in which no additional parking is being provided.

Trustee Fitzgerald offered Resolution No. 2019-93 to reserve decision and close the public hearing.
