The application of Anthony Lopez, (Tony's Taco and Tequila, LLC) Lessee, 262 Jericho Turnpike, Floral Park, NY is made in accordance with Article III, Section 99-11 B(1) of the Zoning Ordinance of the Incorporated Village of Floral Park, NY which requires that when a building is used for restaurant, diner, tavern, bar and grill, drive-in restaurant in a B-2 District, the use may only be authorized as a Special Use Permit authorized by the Board of Trustees.

Trustee Fitzgerald offered Resolution No. 2020-82 to reserve decision and moved to close the public hearing.
