A Work Session was held on Tuesday, September 22, 2020 at 7:00 pm in Firefighters' Hall in Village Hall. In attendance were Mayor Dominick Longobardi, Trustees Kevin Fitzgerald, Lynn Pombonyo, Archie Cheng and Frank Chiara, Village Administrator Gerry Bambrick, Village Clerk Susan Walsh and Police Commissioner Stephen McAllister.

The purpose of the Work Session was to interview police candidates for the position of Police Officer.

At 7:10 pm, Trustee Fitzgerald motioned to go into Executive Session, Trustee Pombonyo seconded, and carried unanimously. The Village Board conducted police interviews. At 8:55 pm Trustee Cheng motioned to come out of Executive Session, seconded by Trustee Chiara and carried unanimously. No action was taken.

Trustee Cheng offered Resolution No. 2020 - 178 to authorize the Village of Floral Park to enter into an Intermunicipal Agreement with Nassau County wherein Nassau County will provide \$17,000.00 to the Village for the purchase of Taser equipment with a useful life of no less than 5 years and authorized the Mayor or Village Administrator to sign same.
