MAYOR LONGOBARDI: Thank you, Miss Walsh.

Okay. I would now like to place on the record that the Board had previously adopted a negative declaration meaning that the proposed local law has no significant impact upon the environment.

I would also like to include the

legislation intent of the law, this local law, adds to the definition of a home office to the zoning. To make clear, such uses are permitted in residential dwellings.

I would also like to read the authority of the law, section 99-3-B, as amended, to include home office, accessories used within a dwelling that involves activities which only require the use of typical light office equipment and which involves no non-residential employees, no business related visits, no warehouse customary inventory and no signage.

The reason we are doing this now is, as many of you know, with Covid 19 and everybody working from home, a lot of people have begun using their home as their office. Many of them maybe using a dining room table, maybe the couch in the living room, but again, we wanted to have a definition of what a home office will be allowed to be in our Village.

With that, I will ask the Board if they have any comments on this local law that they wish to enter into the record at this point?
