

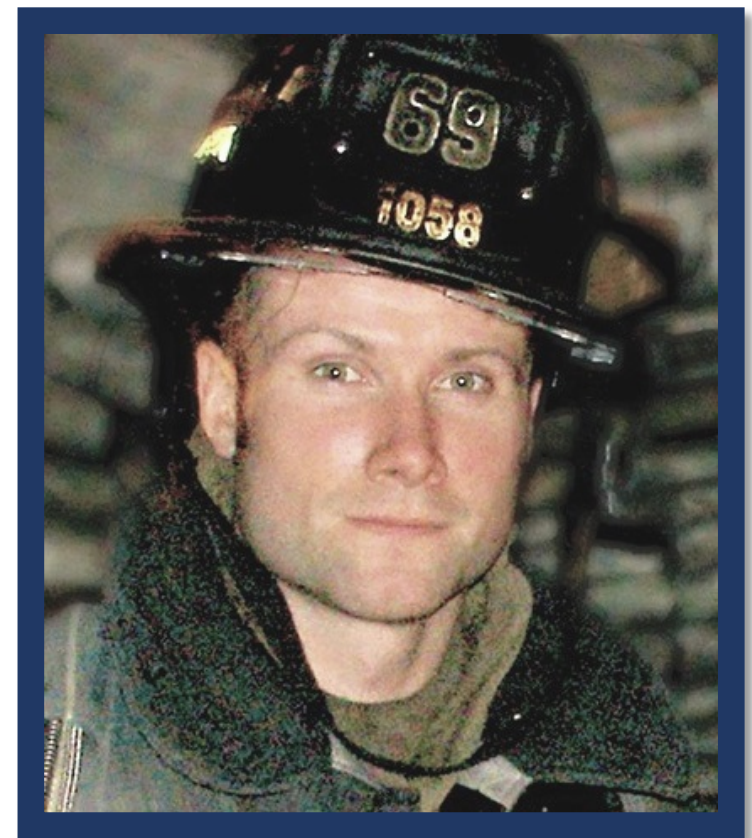

Lieutenant Michael R. Davidson was a 15-year veteran of the FDNY, serving with Engine Company 69 (the Harlem Hilton). He was appointed 4 May 2003. This is the same engine company were his father served prior to his retirement. His brother, Eric, is also a fire-fighter, serving in the Bronx.

Lieutenant Davidson was educated at Archbishop Molloy High School in Queens and Iona College in New Rochelle.

Michael received numerous decorations for Bravery in the line of duty during his career.

He is survived by his wife, Eileen, four children, his parents, and brother.

Recently, two bills have been approved by the New York City Council to help improve the safety for New York City's firefighters in the wake of Lieutenant Davidson's death.
