- e) Approve Edwin Guerrero-Lopez to be appointed as auto mechanic, currently an auto mechanic aide, at the contractual rate of \$64,642.00 subject to Nassau County Civil Service Commission approval and probationary period;
- f) Accept the resignation of John J. O'Grady, Safety Inspector, effective February 6, 2022 after nearly 29 years;
- g) Temporarily promote Police Officer Joseph Lauria to the rank of Sergeant, pursuant to Section 64 of the New York State Civil Service Law, with such promotion to last for the duration of the medical leave of Sgt. Cosmo until May 31, 2022, unless sooner terminated or extended further at the discretion of the Village. During the term of this temporary appointment, Officer Lauria will receive the contractual rate of pay of \$172,810.00 provided by the Collective Bargaining Agreement between the Village and the Floral Park Police Benevolent Association for the rank of Sergeant and, upon the termination of this temporary appointment, Officer Lauria shall revert to the rank of police officer and his rate of pay shall revert to the rate of pay of a police officer then in effect for an officer with the length of service of Officer Lauria pursuant to the CBA.
- h) Approve Alexander Hickey, Laborer in Public Works Department to permanent status since he successfully completed his six-month probationary period and appoint him as a MEO Trainee since he obtained his CDL license at the contractual rate of \$41,498 subject to NC Civil Service approval and drug/alcohol clearances;
- i) Approve the proposal of LKB Engineering for their full-time inspection services of Marshall Avenue Roadway Reconstruction Project from Orchid St. to Covert Avenue in the amount of \$20,000.00 and authorize Mayor or Village Administrator to sign said proposal;
- j) Approve the proposal of D&B Engineers for finalizing the design of Spooner Street from Plainfield Avenue to South Tyson Avenue; Hinsdale Avenue from Jericho Turnpike to Lowell

Avenue; and the Municipal Parking Lot located on Spooner Street in the amount of \$50,350.00 as outlined in their proposal and authorize Mayor or Village Administrator to sign said proposal;

k) Authorize Village Clerk to sign Nassau County Polling Place Agreement granting permission to NC Board of Elections to use the Holland Avenue Firehouse on June 28, 2022 (primary election) and on Tuesday, November 8, 2022 for the General Election from 5 am to 9:30 pm at the rate of \$70.00 per district subject to receipt of certificate of insurance;

l) Authorize the Mayor or Village Administrator to sign an amended 44<sup>th</sup> Year Community Development Block Grant Agreement for the accessibility project at the library which extends the term through August 31, 2023;
