Request to:

- k) Authorize the construction of road and drainage improvements on various roads stating the estimated maximum cost thereof is \$650,000, appropriating said amount for such purpose, and authorize the issuance of bonds in the principal amount of not to exceed \$650,000.00 to finance said

l) Authorize replacement of police and fire communications tower stating the estimated maximum cost there is \$155,000, appropriating said amount for such purpose, and authorize the issuance of bonds in the principal amount of not to exceed \$155,000.00 to finance said appropriation;

m) Authorize the purchase of 100 Motorola radios in the amount of \$39,995.00 for the fire department under NYS Contract and authorize Mayor or Village Administrator to sign said contract;
