

The Long Island Rail Road's new train schedule starts Monday, February 27th and includes several changes and increased service for Floral Park. This includes half-hourly service on the weekends and at night, post-peak hours (instead of hourly service). The Village received the following from the MTA/LIRR about the increased service:

Changes are going to be coming to our schedules on February 27th as we open our new terminal in eastern Manhattan, Grand Central Madison. It's opening will allow us to run 40% more service systemwide than we are currently running, offer more off peak/reverse commute options and give us much needed operational flexibility.
