- 6/20/23 - TRUSTEES - LOCAL LAW 2 of 2023 -

1 MAYOR FITZGERALD: Good evening and
2 welcome to Village Hall, those of you who are
3 here and those of you on Zoom. Tonight we have
4 a public hearing on the local law. Then we'll
5 go to the agenda followed by Board Reports and
6 then we'll open up for questions, comments or
7 concerns from residents.

8 With that, Miss Walsh, can you start with
9 the Local Law.

10 MS. WALSH: Thank you, Mayor Fitzgerald.
11 Legal Notice Incorporated Village of Floral
12 Park, Notice of Public Hearing Local Law Number
13 2 of 2023.

14 Please Take Notice that pursuant to
15 Article 9 of the New York State Constitution,
16 the provisions of the Code of the Incorporated
17 Village of Floral Park and the Municipal Home
18 Rule Law of the State of New York, as amended,
19 a public hearing will be held in the
20 Incorporated Village of Floral Park at the
21 Village, One Floral Boulevard, Floral Park on
22 the 20th day of June, 2023 at 8:00 in the
23 evening of that day, to consider enactment of a
24 local law entitled: "A Local Law Repealing
25 Section 99.25.D of the Code of the Incorporated

1 Village of Floral Park."

2 This local law shall take effect
3 immediately upon its filing with the Secretary
4 of State, dated June 9, 2023 By Order of the
5 Board of Trustees Incorporated Village of
6 Floral Park, New York, Susan E. Walsh, Village
7 Clerk.

8 This legal notice has been published in
9 the official paper of the Incorporated Village
10 of Floral Park, New York, and posted according
11 to law and was sent to the Nassau County
12 Planning Commission and pursuant to Section
13 239-L&M of the General Municipal Law determined
14 to defer to the Village to take action as
15 deemed appropriate.

16 MAYOR FITZGERALD: Thank you. I would
17 like to announce the Board had previously
18 adopted a resolution determining that the
19 application does not have a significant impact
20 on the environment.

21 Just a brief overview of what this is. I
22 guess what it is not. Since there's no state
23 code requiring such we are rescinding local law
24 2 to remove the monetary, time and burden on
25 pool owners to renew their permits annually.

- 6/20/23 - TRUSTEES - LOCAL LAW 2 of 2023 -

1 Revisions of the local law does not repeal the
2 installing of a new pool or modify an existing
3 pool. These residents that have pools are
4 still required to abide by all codes and laws
5 including Floral Park Village, New York State
6 and Nassau County, including, but not limited
7 to pools and barrier regulations.

8 With that, is there anyone on the Village
9 Board that would like to comment on this?
10 Seeing none, is there anybody in the audience
11 that would like to comment about this? Is
12 there anyone on Zoom that would like to comment
13 about this? Raise your hand and Darlene will
