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MAYOR FITZGERALD: With that, we would like to move to introduce Local Law Number 2.

Mr. O'Grady.

MR. O'GRADY: Yes, Mr. Mayor. The Notice of Public Hearing was posted. Please Take Notice that pursuant to Article 9 of the New York State Constitution, the provisions of the Code of the Incorporated Village of Floral Park and the Municipal Home Rule Law of the State of New York, as amended, a public hearing will be held in the Incorporated Village of Floral Park at the Village Hall, One Floral Boulevard, Floral Park on the 21st day of May, 2024 at 8:00 in the evening of that day, to consider enactment of a Local Law entitled: A Local Law amending section 81-8 of the Code of the Incorporated Village of Floral Park, which regulates the chaining of bicycles and other similar equipment.

MAYOR FITZGERALD: I'd like to announce that the Board had previously adopted a resolution determining that the application does not have a significant impact on the environment.

Just real quick with this Local Law. We

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have seen a little bit uptick of people chaining bicycles to parking meters and obstructing sidewalks in certain places and we want to have someway to enforce those being removed and we need to have this Local Law to do that. There's an exception for children under 10 or a baby doing that. If a child is going to the pizza store and puts their bike on the chain, that's not what this is intended for.
