MR. O'GRADY: Yes. Legal Notice was posted for proposed Local Law Number 3 of 2024. Please Take Notice that pursuant to Article 9 of the New York State Constitution, the provisions of the Code of the Incorporated Village of Floral Park and the Municipal Home Rule Law of the State of New York, as emended, a public hearing will be held in the Incorporated Village of Floral Park at the Village Hall, One Floral Boulevard, Floral Park on the 21st day of May, 2024 at 8:00 in the evening of that day, to consider enactment of a Local Law entitled, A Local Law amending section 99-21.2 of the Code of the Incorporated Village of Floral Park to prohibit transient rentals of residential pools and yards.

MAYOR FITZGERALD: I would like to announce that the Board had previously adopted a resolution determining that the application does not have a significant impact on the environment.

The intent of this Local Law is to prevent folks from renting out their yards and/or pools
