MAYOR FITZGERALD: Good evening and welcome to Village Hall for the July board meeting. This evening, we have two public hearings followed by the agenda and board reports and then we will hear questions, comments from the residents.

Without further ado, I turn it over to Mr. O'Grady for the first public hearing.

JOSEPH O'GRADY: First public hearing will be for Local Law Number 4.

Please Take Notice that pursuant to
Article 9 of the New York State Constitution,
the provisions of the Code of the Incorporated
Village of Floral Park and the Municipal Home
Rule Law of the State of New York, as amended,
a public hearing will be held in the
Incorporated Village of Floral park at the
Village Hall, One Floral Boulevard, Floral Park
on the 16th day of July, 2024 at 8:00 in the
evening of that day, to consider enactment of a
Local Law entitled, "A Local Law amending

Section 83-11 of the Code of the Incorporated Village of Floral Park."

This Local Law shall take effect immediately upon its filing with the Secretary of State. Dated June 28, 2024. By Order of the Board of Trustees Incorporated Village of Floral Park, New York, Joseph O'Grady, Village Clerk.

MAYOR FITZGERALD: Specifically, it is the law that allows the village code to be amended to reduce the number of years the volunteer fire department to be eligible for the property tax exemption from the current of five years to two years.

I announce the Board previously adopted a resolution determining that the application does not have a significant impact on the environment.

This law, as I mention, is to reduce the tax exemption for the Volunteer Fire Department to live in the Village from five years to two years. I hope it is an aide in the recruitment of firefighters, that not only this Village needs, but the surrounding communities need. In my opinion, every little bit helps.

We're currently facing a difficult time in recruiting members, retaining members and we only feel that this is a boost in attracting, particularly new members, retaining them and boost the morale of the department. I am in favor of this motion. Thank you.
