E-WASTE RECYCLING PICKUP

Pick up will be on a <u>daily call-in basis</u>.

<u>MUST</u> call DPW 24 hours in advance at 516-326-6320 to schedule a pick up. *CALL DPW FOR A LIST OF ACCEPTABLE ITEMS*.

FREON PICKUP

Air conditioners, refrigerators, freezers, water coolers, dehumidifiers

Pick up will be on a **daily call-in basis**.

MUST call DPW 24 hours in advance at 516-326-6320 to schedule a pick up

YARD WASTE PICKUP

All grass clippings, leaves & small twigs and branches should be placed in clear plastic bags or in covered garbage containers marked "YARD WASTE".

Loose logs, branches and small bundles of wood must be bundled and tied, not to exceed 4' in length.

IT IS ILLEGAL TO RAKE LEAVES INTO THE STREET
All landscapers must possess a permit to operate in Floral Park and are required to remove all grass clippings and leaves on their own vehicles.

INFECTIOUS OR MEDICAL WASTE MAY NOT BE PUT OUT FOR COLLECTION.

PAINT CANS, COOKING OIL AND PROPANE TANKS ARE <u>NOT</u> ACCEPTED AND <u>CANNOT</u> BE DROPPED OFF AT DPW GARAGE.
