10 Local Law number 5?

12 Legal notice of the
13 Incorporated Village of Floral Park.

14 Please take notice that
15 pursuant to Article 9 of the New York
16 State Constitution, the provisions of
17 the Code of the Incorporated Village
18 of Floral Park and the Municipal Home
19 Rule Law of the State of New York, as
20 amended, a public hearing will be
21 held in the Incorporated Village of
22 Floral Park at the Village Hall, one
23 Floral Boulevard, Floral Park on the
24 19th day of November, 2024 at
25 8 o'clock in the evening of that day

1 to consider enactment of Local Law
2 entitled: "A Local Law amending
3 Section 99-5 of the Code of the
4 Incorporated Village of Floral Park
5 to add Paragraph D.1 establishing a
6 Parking Trust Fund."

7 This Local Law shall take effect
8 immediately upon its filing with the
9 Secretary of State. Dated
10 October 16, 2024 by the Board of
11 Trustees of the Incorporated Village
12 of Floral Park.

13 MAYOR FITZGERALD: I would
14 like to announce that the Board
15 previously adopted a negative
16 declaration meaning that the
17 proposed Local Law has no
18 significant impact under SEQRA.

19 A little background on this.
20 The Public Trust Fund is for the
21 purpose of receiving funds upon the
22 granting of alternative parking
23 variances, and further, for the
24 purpose of providing a source of
25 funds for the provision of future

1 municipal off-street parking, which
2 could include access of lands for
3 such purpose.
