2. Resolution No. 2025 - Approve the Schedule of Accounts Payable as follows:

- **3.** Resolution No. 2025 authorize the retirement pay of Sergeant Dean Mayo as of 1/31/2025 in accordance with the Floral Park PBA contract as outlined subject to review.
- 4. **Resolution No. 2025** to authorize the consulting services of Susan Walsh from February 4, 2025 through February 4, 2026 for the purpose of administrative services and authorize Mayor or Village Administrator to sign the agreement;
- 5. Resolution No. 2025- to authorize the settlement of the tax certiorari proceeding pending in the Supreme Court of Nassau County against the Village of Floral Park with respect to JVM Corporation with real property located at 27 Van Buren Ave., Floral Park identified as Section 32, Block 58, Lots 452, 454, 456 & 458 for tax years 2016/17 thru 2024/25 for a lump sum of \$6,000.00 and a reduction in the assessed value from 45,900 to 42,000;
