A Public Hearing for the Board of Trustees was held on the above date at 8:30 pm.

Village Attorney John Ryan was excused from attending the Public Hearing.

The application made by Rite Aid of New York, Inc., 30 Hunter Lane, Camp Hill, PA 17011, is made in accordance with Chapter 99, Article III, Section 99-11 (B), of the Zoning Ordinance of the Incorporated Village of Floral Park, NY, which states that a building in a B-2 District may be erected, altered or used for any purpose only when authorized by the Board of Trustees as a special use after a public hearing conducted by the Board of Trustees. This application seeks to change the hours of operation to a 24- hour, 7-day-a-week retail store.
